NEED	A program to encourage active participation in life on the land is required to offset adverse effects of the project on the exercise of aboriginal and Treaty rights of the Pimicikamak people and consequent injury to their spiritual relationship with the land, their mental and physical health, and their identity.	
GOAL	To foster, and to offset personal costs of, spending time on the land in preferred locations, and to improve personal safety in the face of increased risks, for Pimicikamak citizens camping overnight within Treaty 5 territory. The ultimate goal is to engage people in the process to heal the land, heal the people and heal the Pimicikamak Nation.

CONSTRAINTS	Initial Program will be open to Pimicikamak citizens residing at Cross Lake, who camp anywhere in Treaty 5 territory. Particulars of individual participation will be confidential. The first-year program will end March 31, 2017, or when total support payments approach \$336,000, whichever is sooner. Program in 17/18 may terminate at any time based on evaluation.	
ASSUMPTIONS / RISK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pimicikamak will defer expansion of the program from beyond Cross Lake, until such time it is proven effective. 	
ROLES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pimicikamak will administer the program. • Individuals must register before leaving and on return. • Registry office will contact SMER in case of overdue return. • Pimicikamak Navigation Response Program will handle emergency response.
